It has been a great start to the year with everyone settling in quickly to the routines of the classrooms. Every year we follow our Jump Start Into Newcomb Park program which includes our fabulous morning at Eastern Beach. Please make sure that the permission forms for this excursion are sent back to school ASAP. Our N, P, S dress up day is on Monday, 12th February –all students dress up with a letter beginning with an N, P or S. Parents and friends are welcome to come to the parade on that day.
